



# Join us for **D203** **Decision for the Future** **Open Houses and Tours**

Following nearly four years of study by three different citizens groups, an architectural review of each of District 203's 21 schools, and a year conferring with Naperville intergovernmental agencies - as well as months spent gathering input through the *Touch the Future* community engagement process - the District 203 Board of Education has voted 7-0 to place a referendum question on the February 5, 2008, ballot, accepting the following recommendations as solutions to District 203's most pressing facilities needs:

- A major renovation of Naperville Central High School on its current site (total cost of \$87.7 million), including a new kitchen that would provide hot lunches to all elementary schools;
- An addition to and renovation of Mill Street Elementary School (total cost \$7.3 million);
- Construction of an Early Childhood Center (\$11 million), on the Huntington Estates property owned by District 203;
- Modifications to Naperville North High School's pool, pool locker area, outside traffic patterns and addition of synthetic turf in stadium (total of \$5.2 million)
- Security modifications at Prairie and Ranch View Elementary Schools, as well as at Washington Junior High School (\$.7 million total).

The complete project cost, including \$3 million in program contingencies, will total \$114.9 million, requiring a \$43 million bond referendum.
