# Admission and Scholarship Requirements and Deadlines

- Do I have to take the ACT and SAT to apply here?
- Can I apply for additional scholarships? If so, where do I find them?
- Do you accept external scholarships?
- What does your admissions timeline look like? What dates should I be aware of?
- What materials are needed for my application?

### Information on the Program (Major/Minors) That Interest You

- What is the student to faculty ratio? Will I be taught by teaching assistants or professors?
- What is the average class size?
- What are your graduation and placement rates?
- Where have recent graduates gone to work and/or study and what are they doing?
- What hands-on experiences do you offer? For instance, internships, research, study abroad?
- What kinds of innovative offerings can I expect in the classroom?
- When do I start my major specific courses?

## **Residence Halls**

- How long would I be required to live in a residence hall?
- What are your meal plans like? What food options are available on campus?
- How will I find a roommate? What if we don't get along? Will I be able to move to another room after classes start?

#### **Student Support Services**

- What services do you offer that will help me succeed once I'm here? Are tutors and advisors readily available?
- Do you provide health care services to support my physical and mental health?
- What kinds of professional training and career support can I expect as a student?

### **Student Life**

- What kinds of student organizations do you have on campus? How many are there?
- Are there opportunities to study abroad? Will you provide examples?
- What kinds of security systems are in place to keep me safe? What is the area surrounding campus like?
- What kinds of services are available for diversity and inclusion? Are there student groups and spaces that promote diversity and inclusion?
