To parents of incoming 5th graders,

It is with great pleasure that the staff of Kennedy welcomes your student and family to our school. This letter is an invitation to the process of transition for all 5th grade families whose students will attend Kennedy beginning in the fall of 2019.

On <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>April 17th</u>, we kick off this process with our annual 5th Grade Parent Evening at Kennedy Junior High School. The evening will include presentations from our leadership teams, introductions to some of our teachers, and the opportunity to have your questions answered by staff and parent volunteers. <u>As the purpose of this event is to inform our parent community</u>, we ask that students and siblings do not attend.

We recognize that attendees of this event have varying experiences with middle school: for some families, this will be the first time a child attends Kennedy, while others have had multiple siblings already attend. To plan an evening to meet the greatest number of needs, we have adapted our format to offer multiple sessions around subjects of interest that will run throughout the evening.

Our evening's session topics are listed below:

- 1. Building tours
- 2. Meet the Kennedy administrative team
 - Instruction and scheduling at the middle school level
 - How to access support for your student
 - Social-emotional learning
 - Opportunities to engage in extra-curricular activities
- 3. Smooth transitions
 - What is the role of the school counselor?
 - Helpful tips for parents in the transition to middle school
- 4. Parent to parent (facilitated by parent volunteers of the Kennedy School Family Community Partnership)
 - What experiences have other parents had that will help answer my questions?

Each of these sessions will run concurrently. Parent guests can elect to attend all or just the sessions they feel they need the most. Our evening's schedule is below and includes a 5 minute passing period between each session.
