History

Originally affiliated with the Parent Teacher Association, the Naperville District 203 General Home & School Association was formed during the Great Depression by parents who wished to keep resources within our community, rather than send dues to a national organization.

An executive board was established to coordinate district-wide initiatives and oversee the establishment and support of divisions at each school.

Purpose

The Naperville District 203 General Home & School Association was established to promote close cooperation, understanding and communication between the school and the home and to provide an avenue by which the volunteer efforts of students and parents/guardians might enhance the school environment and instructional programs.

Home & School supports various programs and services through fundraising activities.
