Program	Description
Battle of the Books & Battle of Books Literature Team Grades 4 and 5	Students will explore a variety of books across genres and will be given ample opportunity to have fun discussing books outside of the classroom setting.
Ready to Learn Grades 1 and 2	There will be 9 stations that help get the brain ready to learn. Students will work on balance, cross lateral movements, motor skill development, vestibular activation, spatial awareness, sensory integration, eye tracking, ocular fitness, exercise, peripheral vision development, patter recognition, and skip counting.
Fit to Learn Grades 3-5	Students will learn how to build proper nutrition, fitness, energy, stress relief, and healthy lifestyles. All activities will help the students become healthier, more active, and ready to learn.
Run Club Grades 3, 4 and 5	Students who are interested in living a healthy lifestyle will have the opportunity to practice their running skills before school.
Beebe Singers Grades 4 & 5	Students will be provided a choral experience with music that is challenging beyond their music class work. Two and three part music will be introduced.
Orff Ensemble Grades 4 and 5	Students who enjoy playing instruments, moving and singing will be provided opportunities to improve in all areas.
Leadership Club Grades 4 and 5	Students will have a chance to learn, foster, and practice the skills it takes to be a leader, while making a positive impact at Beebe and in our community.
Band Holiday Ensemble Grades 4 and 5	Students are provided additional opportunities to practice their skills by learning various holiday songs and then will perform for their peers during the lunch periods.
Beebe Book Club Grades 2 and 3	Students get together once a month to discuss a selected book and do an activity. This I s great opportunity to promote reading and improve communication skills.
Girls on the Run Grades 4 and 5	This program encourages girls to have a healthy lifestyle which includes healthy eating, exercise, how to treat others and how to feel great about yourself. Practice includes a lesson and workout. Girls work toward running a 5k.
Art Club Grade 5	Students will imagine, explore and create works of art.
B2 Problem Solvers Grades 2-5	This program is designed to enrich your child's ability to demonstrate math practice standards through problem-solving. A student must be recommended to participate in this program.
