THE PROBLEM

It is dangerous when medication is taken by someone to whom it was not prescribed, for an off-label purpose or in an incorrect dosage.

The misuse of prescription medications can lead to medical problems and/or addiction.

Some teens that abuse prescriptions think it will be an easy solution for life stressors. In fact, it may cause more problems.

Flushing and throwing away medication can have a detrimental impact on the water supply.

THE SOLUTION

When used as directed, prescriptions are safe and effective.

Discuss the dangers of misusing prescription drugs with your family. Set rules about properly using medication, and monitor your inventory.

Properly dispose of unused and expired medication. Drop boxes are located throughout the city.
