

It's Time to Wrap Up our Fall Fundraiser!

Our Fall Fundraiser was a success, and we thank you for your support. We sold **\$8,097** worth of product, resulting in a profit of **\$3,623** for our school (45% profit). This fundraising effort is important because its profit is used for our students directly - including field trips, birthday books, assemblies, library books, Fun Fair, Mustang Stampede, plus more!

Congratulations to the Kindergarteners:

We would like to congratulate the Kindergarteners for winning our grade-level contest this year. The kindergarteners sold more items per student than any other grade- with **185 items sold** which averages 1.89 items per student. This means that all kindergarteners get to have a special pajama day. In addition, the teachers in this grade will receive a special coffee and pastry treat in the up-coming week!

Our 5th graders came in a close second by selling 178 items averaging 1.47 items sold per student.

Congratulations to Mrs. Sweeney's class for <u>selling the most number of items</u> in any classroom in the school. Her students sold 70 items total.
