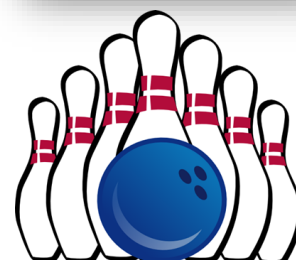
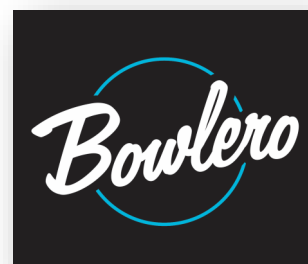
As the program is hosted off-site, parental transportation to and from the bowling alley is required.

How much? \$11.00 per session, **paid in Cash**, each week you bowl.

We encourage you to pre-pay for all 6 sessions, so feel free to bring \$66 in cash the first week of bowling :-)

Cost includes 1 hour of bowling, shoe rental, and a mission of laser tag.

(Participation in all intramurals requires one annual activity fee of \$26; check made payable to Washington Jr. High School – due to the office prior to the first meeting.)

Note: Students are not allowed to enter the carnival/game zone area of the Bowlero complex, as we cannot supervise that area. Thank you for reminding your child of the expectation to remain in the bowling lane area.
