Dear families of 6<sup>th</sup> grade students,

6<sup>th</sup> grade students have the opportunity to select the course pathway for their exploratory period in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades. Students select a two-year cycle from **one** of the following options:

- Applied Arts and Sciences rotation (1 trimester per year each of Art, Family and Consumer Sciences, and Project Lead the Way)
- World and Classical Languages (3 trimesters per year of either French <u>or</u> Spanish) Though they do
  not receive high school credit for the two years of the middle school program, students who take
  two years of either French or Spanish at Kennedy enroll in the corresponding French II or Spanish II
  course as freshmen in District #203.
