Academic

Goal: By Spring 2023, 80% of students will meet or exceed their growth target as measured by the NWEA MAP Growth Reading Assessment.

Rationale for the Goal:

This goal allows us to focus on the individual growth of all students in the area of literacy. Each student will be provided the opportunity to develop their literacy skills by participating in Tier 1 instruction, however may need additional support to fully access their learning and grow as a reader.

Benchmarks for Success:

2021/2022 School Year Data for Targeted Subgroups:

- English Learners: 42% met growth target
- Students with IEPs: 38% met growth target
- Students Who Are Economic Disadvantaged: 39% met growth target
