Naperville is a suburban community of over 144,000 residents. It is located thirty miles west of Chicago on I-88, the high-tech corridor of the western suburbs. The majority of residents are engaged in business, professional, managerial, and technical occupations.

School

Naperville Central High School is a public, fouryear comprehensive high school with 231 certified staff members, a majority of whom have a Master's degree or beyond. The school day consists of eight 50-minute periods. All classes meet 5 days per week during two 18-week semesters. Naperville Central's 2017-18 enrollment is 2,845 including 652 freshmen, 712 sophomores, 687 juniors, 753 seniors and 41 transition students.
