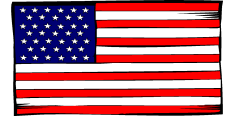

Criteria for Selection for Military Service

- ACT Score: *low* – enlist *moderate* – College ROTC *high* – military academy
- Physical Fitness
- No Criminal Record
- Parent’s permission if < 18 years old
- ASVAB Test (NCHS test site in early November)

Benefits – pay; learn marketable skills; College Education funding, medical insurance

Military Draft - Register for US Military Selective Service (www.sss.gov) Under the law, virtually all male U.S. citizens, and male aliens living in the U.S., who are ages 18 through 25, are required to register with Selective Service.
