

One of the duties of the Vice President is to work with the President to make all Board committee assignments (Policy 2:110).

Each committee below is a superintendent or staff advisory committee. Committees are individuals from the Naperville 203 community who provide guidance, recommendations, and feedback to the superintendent and staff, but without formal decision-making authority. Their role is to offer expertise and insights to help guide the district in future decision making processes. Board members may be assigned to committees as a liaison. The role of a board liaison is primarily to build relationships with the committee members and to be able to share any insight or feedback to the whole Board of Education at a Board meeting as needed.

Membership assignments identify Board of Education delegates to various groups of which the Board of Education or the District hold an active membership.
