

Dear Naperville Community Unit School District 203 Property Owner,

Thank you for supporting the students of Naperville CUSD 203! Please find enclosed a check for your property's portion of the funds distribution to help provide tax relief to the District 203 community.

One of the Board, Superintendent, and District goals is to steward resources effectively. Paramount to this goal is the Board's commitment to providing relief to Naperville 203 property taxpayers whenever possible. The Board has accomplished this in previous years by abating our debt service levy, paying off bonds early and reducing the extension of our general tax levy.

Due to the mandatory closure of schools in March of 2020, District 203 did not expend funds usually used for items such as utilities, gasoline, overtime and other expenses for the last two months of the school year. As a result, the Board is in a unique, one time position, to provide additional relief to its taxpayers. At the January 19, 2021 meeting, the Board of Education adopted a resolution declaring a surplus of funds be distributed to property owners within the boundaries of Naperville CUSD 203 effective January 19, 2021. We are dedicating other portions of this surplus to establishing a safe in person learning environment for students and staff and providing additional support to meet students' academic and social and emotional needs resulting from the pandemic.

As a recipient of this disbursement, it is important that you or your accountant determine the taxability of these funds to satisfy federal and state tax laws.
