Washington is excited to once again provide our students with an opportunity to develop their skills related to science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) through our after school program, <u>FIRST® LEGO® League!</u> 5th-8th grade students will be coached by



Washington school staff as they work together to program an autonomous robot (using the LEGO® PRIME® robot kits) to score points on a thematic playing surface. This year's challenge theme, *SUPERPOWERED*, has students explore machines that move us, challenge the way wireless technology connects us, and innovate ways to improve how we collect, store, and use energy for the future. While the majority of our time will be spent working together on our challenge, we do anticipate a competition with other schools taking place in November for 5th grade and December for 6-8th grade. Our mission in providing this opportunity is to not only support those students who show great interest in STEM, but also to provide all students with opportunities to nurture their interests and grow their ability to function as a member of a collaborative team. A major component of the FLL program is the Core Values. Here we strive to provide students with a foundation for teamwork through fun, Gracious Professionalism, and Coopertition (which, yes, is a combination of cooperation and competition). This is a necessary component since students will work within and across teams to foster a sense of community collaboration.

We will meet on Tuesday afternoons from 2:50-4:10pm in the PLTW room <u>AND</u> Thursday mornings from 7:10-7:50am starting on September 6th. Occasionally, we will have Friday sessions and Saturday sessions. More information about those will follow. Please check the schedule for any updates. It is expected that students are able to attend each session so that teams are prepared for the competition. Families will need to provide transportation for their student promptly at 4:10pm and 7:10am respectively.
