Your Naperville North Counselors wanted to let you know that the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is now open. With that in mind, we wanted to provide you with a few quick bits of information:

- The official FAFSA website is: <https://www.studentaid.gov>
- The application is **free** - you should never be asked to pay for the FAFSA
- Make sure you complete the **2022-2023 FAFSA** (for the year you will be attending college, not the current year).
- Completing the FAFSA is one way to meet the [State of Illinois Financial Aid Graduation Requirement](#).
