# Senior Year

## August – September

- Narrow down your prospective college list
- Attend the Senior Week presentation (August)
- Attend our Senior Evening Program
- Register for AP Tests (if applicable)
- Attend college visits in the Postsecondary Advising & Resource Center (The PARC)
  - o Visits begin in September
  - o **Click here** for instructions on how to sign-up for these visits
- Read over the FAFSA State Graduation Requirement information (\*\*Coming Fall\*\*)
  - o Planning to complete the FAFSA? Go to <a href="https://fsaid.ed.gov/">https://fsaid.ed.gov/</a> and create an FSA ID
  - o Both you AND your parent need to have separate FSA IDs to complete the FAFSA

#### October – December

- FAFSA application (should) open October 1. Complete the application as soon as possible
  - o Class of 2026: Make sure you complete the 2026-27 FAFSA (when it opens)
- Watch your deadlines (many colleges have November 1<sup>st</sup>/15<sup>th</sup> or December 1<sup>st</sup> application and/or scholarship deadlines
- Visit your top college choices (and make sure it's an official visit)
  - o On-Campus Visit Tips are also available
- Begin searching for outside funding or scholarships (check the SchooLinks scholarship list for more information)

### January - April

- Continue searching for outside funding/scholarships
- Watch the "So I Got Into College...Now What?!" web series
- Check your e-mail accounts (and mailbox) for college acceptance notifications & financial aid packages
- Compare financial aid packages offered by each college
  - o Grants & scholarships are free money loans need to be paid back. Remember this!
- Check with your college of choice about the details of signing financial aid award letters
- Make your final decision (by May 1<sup>st</sup>) and send in your deposit
  - o Notify your other prospective schools that you will not be attending

#### May

- Complete the Senior Year End Activity in Schoolinks. This provides data for future grads!
  - o <u>This survey also is your Final Transcript Request Form.</u> We need this data, so we know where to send your final official transcript (the school you will be attending will need it).
- Enjoy your final days of High School. We will miss you when you're gone!
