V. <u>Principal's Report</u> - Gina Baumgartner

A. OSOB Feedback

- a. Family Survey 50%/50% half have continued reading, half have stopped. There were concerns about the content, in particular the character who was sold by their father. Spoke in person with families who were struggling with reading the book as a family. If we continue with OSOB, to do a student survey again for contrast. Aneta: Can parents get the title ahead of time?
- b. Student Survey Ms. Matteson followed up with a survey of students 366 students responded. 216 are reading it. 150 not reading it together.
- c. SFCP group of teachers and parents. Everyone is invited, please consider attending in Spring as we pick the book for next year. Could it be two titles, one for older readers or one for younger readers. Ideas are welcome. Good Reads App, visit that app for reviews.
- B. Open House Feedback did a survey. Got about 10 back. People were happy with it. Two concerns: older students coming back monopolized the time with their former teachers. Also the 1 hour timeframe was tight, especially for multiple kids in the school. Look to expand.
- C. Winter MAP Results what is our % meeting goals and targets. RW: 60% meeting reading, 66% meeting math. Results can be filtered for grade level and indiv teacher in order to see how to best support students.
