The process started in 2017 - there were more minutes in the curriculum than were in the school day. A few years ago, it was proposed to add minutes. Either adjust the district's minutes down or add more to the day. Last year, the Innovative committee again. Paths for struggling, as well as high achieving, students in order to keep striving. More teacher collaboration time. Teachers used to PLC (example:

Meadow Glens was a "sister school"). Students have changed, so practices need to change. Reflect on the engagement of students and their behaviors. Looking at instructional minutes (State, District). How do we limit transitions, how do we schedule so we don't have an outlier "chunk" of time that doesn't work. Team collaboration time, teachers may need time for IEP and coordinating with specialists.

Specific for Elementary....still a proposal, trying to get input from community/teachers. Currently have a 15 min morning meeting. Right now, 4th grade goes straight into specials at the first bell. Would be good to pad transitions, because some minutes get spent from instructional time due to transitioning. Showing an example for first grade, for example it is like a passing period. WIN time: What I Need time. The proposed change is going from 8:15-2:30. So starting at 7:45-2:15. Alisha questioned: additional after school time? Typically Thursdays are 2 staff meetings, leadership team meeting, then committee meetings. Usually 1 meeting a week...contract stipulates the 105 minutes of meetings. AM running club - how early would that start? Afterschool doesn't provide the same benefits. Earlier start has a lot of considerations.

Circling back about "academies" with Mrs. Zuffrano. Seeing gains with skills re: conflict resolution. Nice to see them
