Health Office Update

The Naper health office wants to be sure our families are aware of the upcoming deadlines and programs. If you have any questions or concerns, please call the health office at (630) 420-6347. [Kindergarten and Students New to Illinois](#)

- A physical examination on an Illinois Physical form within one year before the first day of school with updated immunizations is due by October 15, 2024.
- A vision examination by an eye doctor on an Illinois Eye Exam form completed within one year of the first day of school is due by October 15, 2024.
- A dental exam on an Illinois Dental Exam form dated between November 15, 2023, and May 15, 2025, is due by May 15, 2025.

2nd Grade

- A dental exam on an Illinois Dental Exam form dated between November 15, 2023, and May 15, 2025, is due by May 15, 2025.

Vision and Hearing Screenings

On 9/6/24 and 9/20/24 the DuPage County Health Department will be at Naper Elementary School providing vision and hearing screenings. Students in kindergarten and 2nd will be given a vision screening, and students in kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will receive hearing screenings. Students with IEPs and those new to D203 will be given both a vision and hearing screening. If you would like to opt out of these screenings, or you have questions, please call the health office at (630) 420-6347. **Please note, this vision screening is NOT a substitute for a complete eye and vision evaluation by an eye doctor, and those students in kindergarten or are new to Illinois will still need to submit a State of Illinois Eye Examination form if they have not already done so.**

FREE Dental Screening at Naper

The DuPage County Health Department will be at Naper Elementary School on September 30 to provide FREE dental screenings to all students who return a consent form. We encourage all students to take advantage of this FREE screening that will meet the dental examination requirement for kindergarten, 2nd grade, and new to Illinois students. More information and consent forms will be coming home soon!
