PROCEDURES FOR REPORTING STUDENT ABSENCES

District 203 has a consistent procedure for reporting student absences. Parents are requested to phone the Health Office (**630-420-6347**) prior to 7:45 a.m. to report a student absence or delay due to a doctor or dentist appointment. **Our Health Office is equipped with voice mail and calls can be accepted anytime day or night.**

Please provide the following information when calling:

1. Date
2. Student's Name
3. Teacher's Name
4. Reason for Absence



If you anticipate the absence to be more than one day, please call the Health Office again between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. and discuss the absence with the Health Technician.

If a student is absent and we have not received a call, we will attempt to reach you by calling your home and/or a number that you have designated as your emergency contact. We must call these numbers prior to 10:00 a.m. to check on unreported absences. This procedure was developed to ensure the safety of your child as well as to help us with our attendance reports.
