The following is a summary of the programs and services available at NPL:



Books, Computers and iPads

A wide variety of books at various reading levels to engage and encourage early literacy and learning.

Personalized reading lists to suit every reader at any level.

In-house computers and iPads with preloaded games and activities.



Programs Galore

Exciting activities that encourage critical thinking such as STEAM-based programs, the Summer and Winter Reading Programs, and early literacy programming throughout the year.

All Children's programs are free and a calendar of events can be found on the library's website.



Special Collections

Book collections in world languages including Arabic, Chinese, French, Hindi, Marathi, Polish, Spanish, Russian and Tamil.

VOX Picture Books enable children to listen and read along with a recorded narration.

The Easy Readers collection offers books labeled according to their level of difficulty using a numbered system, from 1 for emergent readers to 3 for advanced early readers.
