Dear Jefferson Families,

We hope that you are having an enjoyable summer, and we are looking forward to the 2022-2023 school year! For those who are new to Jefferson this year, I am confident that you will find our staff to be caring and supportive in your transition. Listed below is important information about registration and the start of school. Please look it over carefully and call the school at 630-420-6363 if you have any questions.

The school year officially begins on Wednesday, August 17, 2022, and the school day starts at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 2:50 p.m. Buses will operate on that first day as well. **Transportation information can be accessed in the Campus Portal (<http://www.Naperville203.org>) starting on August 11<sup>th</sup> at 3:00p.m.** Please check back frequently leading up to the start of school as there may be changes in routes and pick-up times. If you need assistance regarding transportation information, call the Transportation Department at 630-420-6464.

**Student class schedules will be available online on August 9<sup>th</sup> after 3:00p.m.** Please print your student's schedule with the locker combination and bring it with you on the designated date so they can set up their locker and walk their schedule. When printing the schedule, please select "schedule with locker and combo." You may not be able to view the locker combinations on your cell phone. If you are unable to print their schedule, you may receive assistance from the Jefferson main office.

More than one third of our students are new each year, and we understand the importance of ensuring that all students feel comfortable at their new school. As a result, we are actively planning and are hopeful that we will be able to provide an opportunity for all students to come in prior to the start of school to set up their lockers, walk their schedules, and purchase a PE uniform if needed. PE Uniforms will be available to purchase for anyone who missed the deadline or needs a new uniform. PE shirts are \$12. Parents are also welcome to attend with their child at their assigned time.

\*Please note that Jefferson will be closed Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday, August 16<sup>th</sup> as staff meetings and professional learning will be occurring at this time. Our office staff will continue to accept phone and email questions during this timeframe.

The JJHS School Counselor will be welcoming incoming 6th graders and newly enrolled 7th and 8th graders and their families to join us for the Where Everybody Belongs (WEB) Orientation on August 9th at 8:00a.m. The orientation program begins at 8:00a.m. with our WEB assembly; building tours and locker set-up will take place afterward until 10a.m. Bus transportation (for students only) will be available at students' typical morning pick-up time with their assigned bus number. Buses will depart JJHS at 10:00a.m. Students may also be dropped off, and parents are welcome to attend.
