Stage III Hybrid Learning-planned for the end of January 2021

Mrs. Mitchell discussed the rationale behind the return to learning being half days. Half days were chosen for consistency with learning in consideration for holidays, transportation, lunch, etc. Focus will be on SEL, reading and math for synchronous time.

Teacher Assistants will be assisting K-2 during asynchronous time. Third to Fifth grades will have more office hours available to them. Two building substitutes who are available may also support students during asynchronous time.

Technology will also allow students who are at home to interact with students and teachers at school. Students who are in person will be able to leave items in their desks.

Kindergarten students' parents should have received a letter that there will be Kindergarten tours on January 22nd so the students are not overwhelmed the first day they return to the building.
