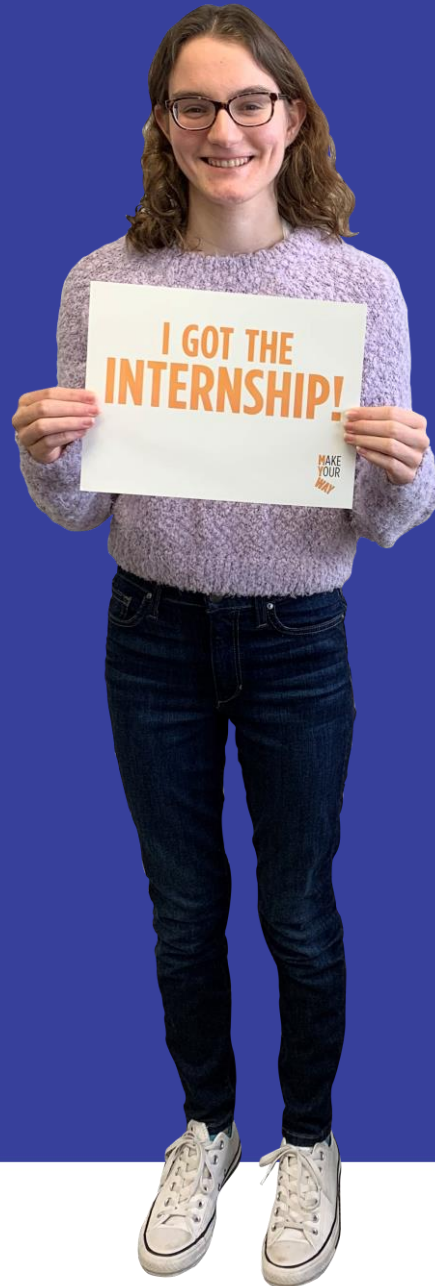

- \$50 in gas cards per month while attending classes if the school is 15 miles or more from your home.
Additional requirements apply and will be discussed with your career counselor
- \$500 completion bonus for maintaining monthly contact with your counselor, successfully completing school and obtaining training related employment**

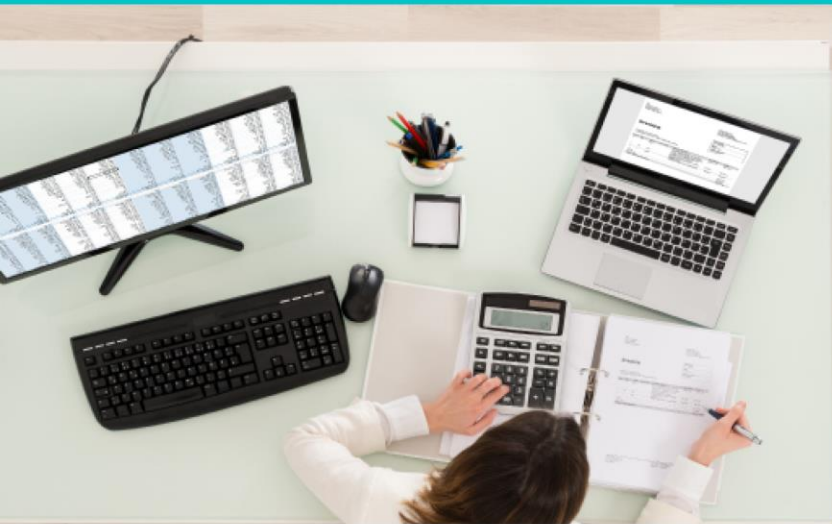

WHO WE HELP

Eligibility requirement guidelines

NOT attending school 24 years old or younger

Must be:

Authorized to work in U.S.

Selective Service (if applicable)

And one of the following:

- Has been **arrested** before
- Has any type of documented **disability** (IEP, learning disability, mental health, physical)
- Is currently **homeless, foster child, or aged out of foster care**
- Has not earned a **high school diploma, GED/HSE**
- **Living in a low-income** household
 - Someone in household is currently, or was previously, receiving food stamps or other public assistance;
 - Applicant is working part-time and earning low wages

Currently attending school (high school or college) they must be:

- **Authorized to work in U.S.**
- **Selective Service (if applicable)**
- **21 or younger** and;
- **Living in a low-income** household
 - Someone in household is currently, or was previously, receiving food stamps or other public assistance;
 - Applicant is working part-time and earning low wages;
 - Or has a disability and has low or no income
