## Naper Luminarias

#### Dear Naper Family,

Please help Naper Elementary light up our neighborhood to ring in 2022. Join us in celebrating the New Year by lining our streets with candle luminarias on **December 31st** and transforming our neighborhood into a beautiful winter village!



Each luminaria consists of a votive candle placed in 2-3 inches of sand inside a paper bag. Luminaria kits are sets of **5 candles and bags** with sand for **\$5/kit**. Luminaria are spaced 3-4ft apart and are lined along sidewalks and driveways. The typical house would use 3-7 kits. Everyone should aim to light their candles at 6:30pm, which should illuminate our neighborhood until we ring the new year in at midnight.

## Winter Is Coming

#### Hello Naper Families!

With the weather getting colder and more families driving their students to and from school, we thought we'd take a moment to share some tips to keep your child safe.

#### Car Pool Lane

While we have had pretty great weather this fall, once the cold and snow hits, it has a dramatic effect on our carpool lane. To help keep our students safe, and to help manage the flow of traffic, please keep these rules in mind:

- $\cdot$  Pull ahead as far as you can in the drop off zone
- · Students should only enter/exit their vehicle in the drop off zone (by the playground)
- · Students should only enter/exit their vehicle on the passenger side
- · As you approach the school have the children ready to exit the vehicle

• Students may enter/exit their vehicle on their own, but if the student needs assistance, please have them wait for a staff member. Adults should not get out of their car.

 $\cdot$  Once the students are safely in or out of the car, please exit the carpool lane, but yield to traffic on your left.

One final note, at times your student may have to walk through a bit of snow as they enter/exit their vehicle. Thus, it's a good idea to have them wear their boots to and from school.

#### Crosswalk

Just as a reminder for families that still walk to school, please cross the street at either Eagle and Benton, or Eagle and Jefferson. The city removed the crosswalk at Eagle and Van Buren, thus it is not safe to cross there.

#### Winter Weather Gear

Students will go outdoors unless the wind-chill index is below 0F or if there is precipitation at recess time. With that in mind, please make sure your student has the appropriate winter weather gear which includes boots, hats, gloves and a coat. Boots and snow clothes are

required to play in the snow. Otherwise students will be asked to remain on the cleared area of the blacktop.
