

Arrival and Dismissal

Hello Naper Families! The safety of Naper students is of utmost importance to us. Please review these reminders for arrival and dismissal at Naper School. Thank you so much for your cooperation. We truly are BETTER TOGETHER!

Students may enter at 8am. We do not have teacher supervision until this time each day.

- Please have your student exit the car anywhere along the fence. You do not need to wait for Mr. M to open your car door, unless your child needs adult assistance to exit the vehicle.
- Cars should only drop off in the car pool lane along the fence. Please do not pull past this area and drop off directly in front of the school. Please try to say your goodbyes in the drop off lane, when parents wait in front of the school to wave goodbye to their child it creates a traffic issue on Eagle Street and Van Buren.
- Students should wear boots for arrival as they may need to walk through snow.
- Parents should not exit the car and students should only exit on the passenger side of the car.
- Naper School has crosswalks at Eagle Street and Benton and Eagle Street and Jefferson. Please do not cross Eagle Street at any other location with children.
- Please do not park in the car pool lane.
- Students may only play on the playground after school IF a parent is present.

MITIGATION STRATEGIES

The health and safety of students and staff is of utmost importance to all of us! We have a layered mitigation process to keep us as safe as possible. Hand washing and sanitizing, social distancing, masks and Shield Testing are truly helping to reduce the spread and provide early detection. Many may have opted out of Shield Testing once they were vaccinated. This variant seems to impact many vaccinated people (although not as severely), please consider opting in for Friday Shield Testing as we strive to keep Naper as healthy as possible. How to get started:

- 1. Download the SecurlyHome App.
- 2. Enter the parent email address you have registered in Infinite Campus.
- 3. Check your email from your phone for an email from Securly titled "Your Securly login link" then click on the link they provide. Your account is now ready to go!


HEALTH OFFICE REMINDERS:
