Note from Naper Health Office

Parents / Guardians of students who have medication in the Naper health office: Please be sure to pick up your student's medication from the health office by 3 pm on 5/26/22 or 5/27/22. Per district policy, any medication left after this time will be destroyed.

Parents / Guardians of students with life threatening allergies, asthma and seizures: Please be sure to obtain a new action plan for the 2022-2023 school year. Be sure to bring your students action plan and medication (if ordered) to the health office before the first day of school. Be sure the medication ordered matches **EXACTLY** what you bring in to the health office.

Parents / Guardians of students entering kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades for the 2022-2023 school year: Physical exams must be completed for students entering these grades no earlier than 1 year prior to the entrance of the required grade, and are due by October 15, 2022. Please be sure as the parent / guardian of the student, you complete the parent portion of the physical form before turning it in. As a reminder, sports physicals are **NOT** accepted as the required physicals for kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades; however, the Child Health Examination form you receive for these physicals **WILL** count as the child's sports physical for that year.

Parents / Guardians of students entering kindergarten, 2nd, 6th and 9th grades for the 2022-2023 school year: The State of Illinois requires these students to have a dental examination that was performed any time within an 18-month period prior to the due date of May 15, 2023.

Parents / Guardians of students entering kindergarten for the 2022-2023 school year: The State of Illinois requires these students to have an eye examination completed before October 15, 2022.

Please remember to schedule the health examination(s) early if still needed to allow time for their completion.

Arrival and Dismissal

Hello Naper Families! The safety of Naper students is of utmost importance to us. Please review these reminders for arrival and dismissal at Naper School. Thank you so much for your cooperation. We truly are BETTER TOGETHER!

Students may enter at 8am. We do not have teacher supervision until this time each day.

- Please have your student exit the car anywhere along the fence. You do not need to wait for Mr. M to open your car door, unless your child needs adult assistance to exit the vehicle.
- Cars should only drop off in the car pool lane along the fence. Please do not pull past this area and drop off directly in front of the school. Please try to say your goodbyes in the drop off lane, when parents wait in front of the school to wave goodbye to their child it creates a traffic issue on Eagle Street and Van Buren.
- Students should wear boots for arrival as they may need to walk through snow.
- Parents should not exit the car and students should only exit on the passenger side of the car.
- Naper School has crosswalks at Eagle Street and Benton and Eagle Street and Jefferson. Please do not cross Eagle Street at any other location with children.
- Please do not park in the car pool lane.

- Students may only play on the playground after school IF a parent is present.

MITIGATION STRATEGIES

The health and safety of students and staff is of utmost importance to all of us! We have a layered mitigation process to keep us as safe as possible. Hand washing and sanitizing, social distancing, masks and Shield Testing are truly helping to reduce the spread and provide early detection. Many may have opted out of Shield Testing once they were vaccinated. This variant seems to impact many vaccinated people (although not as severely), please consider opting in for Friday Shield Testing as we strive to keep Naper as healthy as possible.
