Naper Health Office Update

1. Siblings of ill students may remain attending in-person learning, as long as:
 - a. They are not showing signs of illness **AND**
 - b. Verification that the sick student received a COVID-19 test is presented to the health office within 24 hours. *The verification must be that the COVID-19 test was completed, not just that the test is scheduled.*

2. An alternative diagnosis is no longer accepted. If a student is showing signs of COVID-19 illness, an RT-PCR test must be completed, or the student must remain home for 10 days from the onset of illness.
