

Covid Shield Testing Volunteers Needed

Covid Shield testing will begin at Naper on Friday, October 1st. Testing will be done every Friday. We are looking for 2 parent volunteers per week to help escort the students to and from their classrooms, and help them with checking in for their test. This will be from 8-11:20am. All volunteers need to be fully vaccinated and wear a mask. Thank you so much for volunteering your time!

Naper Health Office Update

This week brought 2 big changes to the COVID-19 protocol for D203.

- 1. Siblings of ill students may remain attending in-person learning, as long as:
- a. They are not showing signs of illness AND
- b. Verification that the sick student received a COVID-19 test is presented to the health office within 24 hours. *The verification must be that the COVID-19 test was completed, not just that the test is scheduled.*
- 2. An alternative diagnosis is no longer accepted. If a student is showing signs of COVID-19 illness, an RT-PCR test must be completed, or the student must remain home for 10 days from the onset of illness.
