Call to Order

Project Updates NCHS

Naperville Central High School

Tim Bickert, IHC, Reported the following:

- First area steel went up quickly welding in progress
- Next delivery of steel on September 17 for west side of courtyard defining the atrium
- Concrete is proceeding in the basement
- Tie backs finished for structural work
- Precast plank for floors in courtyard area will be delivered in a couple weeks
- So far, there have not been too many complaints about the construction. We have received one Freedom of Information Request related to air quality.
- Mr. Weaver attends the NCHS cabinet meetings
- Field turf is complete staff training for the care of the turf will take place this week
- Asphalt needs time to cure before the top coat is applied. Marty Bee is communicating the time line with students.

Early Childhood Center

Chad Alexander, Lamp Inc. reported the following:

Work in place since last meeting:

- Site grading is 95% complete; soil remediation required at south drive to be complete by early October
- Site Utilities 95% complete working on electric now, running underground conduit out to the street for AT&T.
- East concrete slab poured 9/8.
- Metal stud framing on-going at the west side of the building.
- Interior building structural steel erected, detailing complete by 9/16-exterior canapé will come later
- Roof framing scheduled to start 9/17
- Progress will look slow initially- heavy laminate beams will be delivered 9/17, truss delivery will take place every four days after that at which time there will be significant progress.
- Hoping to condense the schedule in the next few weeks.
- Working hard to get the building closed in to protect the slab from freezing
- Mr. Fielden will make a motion at the September 22 Board of Education meeting to amend the soil allocation to be used for acceleration costs.
- The financials were reviewed no change from last meeting.

NCHS Bids

Tim Bickert, IHC, reported that Bid Release 4 included the South

Addition Elevator, HVAC & Plumbing.

The numbers came in favorably. Only one bidder came in for the elevator

so another bid package will be sent out to re-bid that item. HVAC low bidder was Mechanical Concepts of Illinois Plumbing low bidder was Hartwig Plumbing and Heating.

All three bids will be brought to the Board meeting on September 22 for approval with the recommendation that the elevator bid be rejected and re-

bid.

The next bid release will be for the electric and light fixtures on September 24. Those bids will be brought for approval at the October 5 Board meeting. There will be 25 or so more bid packages in 3 more bid releases; bid 5 will be at the end of the month, bid 5a will be a separate bid for fire protection and bid 6 will be in December for the majority of the rest of the work. There may be a small bid release 7 to clean up a few odds and ends.

NCHS Design Items Craig Siepka and Jim Smiley showed pictures of the interior atrium and brought some samples of the materials to be used on the stairway for

safety and privacy.

There was discussion about the type of fencing to be used around the

football field.
