

District 203 Exterior Space Rental Guidelines - COVID19

All athletic field users must adhere to the restrictions identified in the Restore Illinois Plan issued by the Governor's Office and those listed below. Failure to follow the restrictions may result in the cancellation of the contract and removal of the user from the athletic field and/or facility.

- 1. The Undersigned has carefully reviewed the Guidelines for *Restore Illinois Plan* agrees to its terms.
- 2. All athletes, coaches, spectators, and officials must adhere to 6 foot social distancing practices while at the field, unless play makes it impractical.
- 3. Athletes must wear face coverings at all times while not actively participating in the field of play and when a minimum 6 feet distance cannot be maintained from others.
- 4. Group sizes must not exceed 50 total participants, coaches, and officials (i.e. excludes spectators) while Naperville remains under Phase 4 of the *Restore Illinois Plan*.
- 5. Social distancing is maintained at the venue 30 feet of distance is maintained between groups, including opposing teams on sidelines.
- 6. Officials must adhere to 6 foot social distancing practices when practical, when interacting with players, coaches, and spectators off the field of play.
- 7. Officials must wear face coverings at all times while officiating, and when a minimum 6 foot distance cannot be maintained from others before and after games.
- 8. Officials should avoid exchanging documents or equipment with players, coaches, or spectators
- 9. Individuals should not congregate in common areas or the parking lot following a practice or game.
- 10. Team meetings may only occur in groups of 50 or fewer people, with 6 foot social distancing practices, rather than in a team huddle.
- 11. No high fives, handshake lines, and other physical contact with teammates, opposing players, coaches, officials, and spectators. A "tip the cap" or team cheer can be used following the game or practice in lieu of the handshake line.
- 12. No spitting or eating seeds, gum, or other similar products.



- 13. Participants must bring their own water bottle. No sharing of water bottles between participants is to be permitted. No team water coolers are permitted.
- 14. Hand washing or hand sanitizing are recommended before and after sports activities.
- 15. Violating the District's facility use policy and/or the Restore Illinois Plan may result in termination of your contract.
