General Eligibility

- Age 17-24 at time of application
- Out of School
- Authorized to work in US
- Selective Service Compliance (if applicable)

Barrier to Employment (at least one documented barrier)

- School Dropout
- Pregnant/Parenting
- An Offender
- Homeless
- A Documented Disability (IEP, 504, etc)
- Low Income
