Dr. Rubin's Mini-Medical School is a community service program created in 2004. Our programs are designed to encourage motivated high school students to become physicians and surgeons. The Mini Medical School for High School Students Program is a competitive program. This year we are offering the program to two groups, one meeting on Saturdays and the other on Sundays. This will hopefully allow us to offer the program to all qualified students. We will meet on the following dates:

The Saturday class meets for the first 5 sessions from 3-6 PM with arrival starting at 2:30 PM. The last session is Sunday March 18th at 1-3 PM at Edward Hospital. The Sunday class meets for the first 5 sessions from 2-5 PM with arrival starting at 1:30 PM. The last session is Sunday March 18th at 4-6 PM at Edward Hospital.

The program provides a very intense overview of the typical courses learned in Med School with a series of complementary hands on experiences typical of 2nd and 3rd year med students. Parents are invited to the last session when students will be provided a chance to review all the procedures learned along with their parents and hear a lecture on how to obtain admission to medical school as well as other health fields. We will conclude with our graduation ceremony. Students must be able to attend all 6 sessions to fully benefit from this program.

Admission to this program is competitive. There is no fee to apply. This program is appropriate for advanced sophomores, juniors and senior students. Applications will be processed as they are received. Student finalists will be offered an interview. The deadline for us to receive a complete application is **October 31, 2017**.
