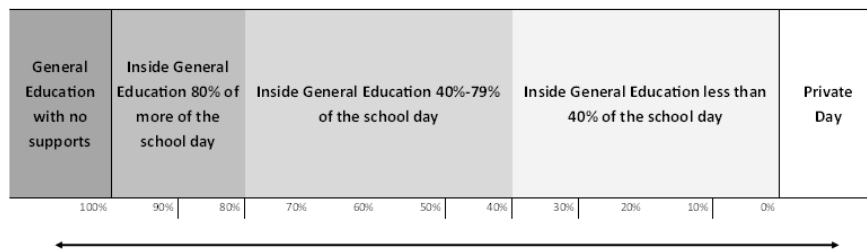


NCUSD #203 Continuum of Services

A full continuum of services is available for all students who qualify for special education. Students with disabilities may receive services exclusively in the general education classroom or within a residential setting, with many other options in between. Services and supports are individually designed by the IEP team and aligned to the educational needs of the student.

NCUSD #203 Specialized Classrooms

The vast majority of our students receive services within their neighborhood schools. Additionally, specialized classrooms are available throughout the district for students who need additional support. Each of the specialized classrooms provides a smaller student/teacher ratio, increased intensity of services and a focused methodology aligned to student’s needs.

Multi-Need Classrooms	Provides a priority curriculum for students with multiple disabilities that focus on authentic and community-based instruction with integrated related services. STARS/Success	Provides a highly structured classroom with an emphasis on building the SEL skills needed to navigate the school environment. Connections	Supports students ages 18-22 who need an extended educational experience in order to fully develop community living, personal, and vocational skills.	5 th Ave Station
