

## NCUSD #203 Continuum of Services

A full continuum of services is available for all students who qualify for special education. Students with disabilities may receive services exclusively in the general education classroom or within a residential setting, with many other options in between. Services and supports are individually designed by the IEP team and aligned to the educational needs of the student.

The vast majority of our students receive services within their neighborhood schools. Additionally; specialized classrooms for students who need more intensive supports are available throughout the district. Each of the specialized classrooms provides an alternative setting, increased intensity of services and a focused methodology aligned to student's needs.

<b>Structured Learning Classrooms</b>	A highly structured classroom with an emphasis on building communication and pragmatic language skills. <b>STARS/Success</b>	Provides a highly structured classroom with an emphasis on building the SEL skills need to navigate the school environment. <b>Connections</b>	Supports students ages 18-22 who need an extended educational experience in order to fully develop community living, personal, and vocational skills.	5 <sup>th</sup> Ave Station
