| Table # | Steps to support student learning in a digital world: |
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| 1 | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Model good behavior2. Teach examples of good/bad posts3. Empower them to learn how to discipline themselves in how they use their digital time and tools4. Re-teach them different things they need to be aware of at different stages of life (elementary vs. Jr. High vs. High School)5. |
| 2 | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Start a conversation by sharing our own digital struggles so they know they are not alone.2. We would like to model and discuss good digital behavior.3. Slow down and set boundaries and know that things really can wait.4. Focus on one thing at a time.5. |
| 3 | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Discussing the need to have followers versus friends2. Mentoring through setting the right example; doing things ourselves3. Have conversations with your children about what they are living in terms of technology4. Use examples in media and text to help start these discussions5. Asking permission to post a picture of someone |

Encourage daughters to use me as an excuse to bow out of uncomfortable or negative conversations 3. It is okay to make a mistake 4. set more parameters, modeling proper behavior, limiting screen time 5. involve the kids in setting house rules |
