Dear Madison Families,

The Madison staff is excited to welcome our students to the 2020-2021 school year, and we are busy making plans to ensure a smooth transition back. This letter shares some important details to assist you in the registration process, and we will continue to communicate throughout the summer to keep you apprised of any changes. Please review this information carefully and don't hesitate to call the school at 630-420-6400 if you have any questions.

The school year officially begins on Wednesday, August 19th, 2020 with transportation and food services. Our school day runs from 8:00 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. Transportation information can be accessed in the Campus Portal (<u>http://www.Naperville203.org</u>) starting on August 10th at 3:00 p.m. Please check back frequently leading up to the start of school since changes can occur in routes and pick-up times. If you need assistance regarding transportation information, call the Transportation Department at 630-420-6464. If you drive your child to school, please be aware of the drop-off protocols and follow the direction of the staff that is there to assist you.

More than one third of our students are new to us each year, and we understand the importance of ensuring that all students feel comfortable at their new school. We also know with an unusual end to last year, some of our students may be experiencing anxiety about returning in August. As a result, we are actively planning and are hopeful we will be able to provide an opportunity for all students to come in prior to school to set up their lockers, walk their schedules, and purchase a PE shirt, if needed. We are carefully monitoring the Re-Store Illinois Plan and intend to continue to follow the Illinois State Governor and Illinois Health Department's guidance as we make decisions for this fall. We will be in touch with dates and processes for this opportunity as more information is available.

Schedules will be available on-line in the Infinite Campus Portal on August 10th after 3:00 p.m. Please print your child's schedule with locker combination and bring it with you on the designated date, to be announced later, to set up your locker and walk your schedule. Anyone without the ability to print their schedule can get assistance through the school's office. Instructions on how to print your schedule are located on our website under the summer registration tab.

Our counselors are planning our 6th grade orientation program, Where Everybody Belongs (WEB), tentatively scheduled for this summer. More information will be sent later when those plans can be confirmed with guidance from the DuPage County Regional Office of Education and the DuPage County Health Department.

A SCHOOL FEES STATEMENT has been included in this mailing. We are requesting that fees be paid by August 3, 2020. Please complete the accompanying fee sheet and return to Madison Junior High School, 1000 River Oak Drive, Naperville, Illinois 60565. All checks should be made payable to School District 203. A penalty charge of \$25.00 will be assessed for each
