Adult social is this Friday! As of 4/10 at 1pm we have 243 people committed. That total does not include tickets (# to be confirmed by Mr. Zallis) for staff that will be paid for by the funds raised by sponsorships. We've also presold over 250 drink tickets. Early estimate on costs from Naperville Country Club for the food, (pre purchased)beverage and service charge is \$12,682.60. This does not include additional drink tickets purchased through Wednesday this week or additional drink tickets purchased night of the event. Other costs will include décor, the DJ, silent auction and raffle displays, a few small game prizes and the GiveSmart Fee.

Thank you to those who signed up to help the night of the social! We are looking for another volunteer to support the check out process. Naperville Country Club is sensitive to these needs and will be providing food labeling at the different stations. Beverages will include a free non-alcoholic self service drink station. Domestic beer, wine and mixed cocktails for purchase through Home&School, drink tickets to be redeemed at the bars. Seltzers are not on the drink menu at Naperville Country Club.

Make sure email addresses and cell phone numbers are registered as well to ensure receipt of reminders and attendee details.
