# H. PRINCIPAL REPORT

- a. Thank You Thank you for a smooth start to the school year and for your attendance at Meet the Teacher as well as Curriculum Night. Students and staff are transitioning back into the routines of school and we are excited about the year ahead.
- b. Parent Teacher Conferences -\_Thursday, October 9th and Friday, October 10th are parent teacher conferences. There is no school on both of these days. Thursday's conferences are 5-8 p.m. Friday's conferences are from 8-12. Conferences are via Zoom. Sign up will go out on 9/17.
- c. Safety Reminders
  - i. Accessing the Building During School
    - 1. Must use Door 1 and be buzzed into the main office
    - 2. Driver's License or State ID will be run through our Raptor System. The system was purged this summer so all parents planning to support at school should have their ID rerun.
      - a. If you plan to be at this school this year and haven't already come in and had your ID scanned, you are encouraged to do so.
    - 3. Issued a Temporary Badge that must be worn the entire time you are visiting the building
  - ii. Supervision Before and After School
    - 1. Students should not be unsupervised in the morning before we open the doors at 8 am.
    - 2. Students playing on the playground or in the fields after school must have adult supervision.

- f. MAP Growth Students in K-5 recently completed their fall MAP Growth assessment in reading and math. Scores will be coming home Friday, September 12th. This assessment is just one data point that provides valuable insights into a student's growth and learning. However, it is important to remember that it is not the sole indicator of a student's progress. Teachers at Prairie use multiple measures to monitor and plan for each student's success, including classroom assessments, observations, daily work, and other formative tools. This comprehensive approach ensures a well-rounded understanding of each student's needs and strengths.

#### 5. Prairie Garden Club

a. Fifteen 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders signed up and are attending on Tuesdays from 2:30-3:15. The fall club sessions traditionally lose members to graduation/competing sports, etc. and the count is down by about 10-15 from spring. A survey of the student and adult attendees was conducted at the first session. Future club activity will focus on identified key interests and appetites. We are harvesting crops planted in the Spring session and planting crops for late fall harvest. We now have 8 beautiful new Vego garden beds on hand to replace the wooden beds that are falling apart. Two more and replacement will be complete. These will be installed as we idle existing beds for the winter. Scheduling the winter shut down with assistance from others is in process. Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts, and Girl Scouts have either helped in the past or expressed interest in helping. Hopefully this will also include filling the new beds. We are aiming for a mid-late October garden shut down/overwinter day.
