- a. Thank you for an incredible year! Thank you to the entire Home & School community and the Home & School Executive Board, including outgoing Co-President Colleen Troupis and outgoing Secretary Allison Kellogg.
- b. From June 4th July 10th, the playground at Prairie will be available for community use Monday-Thursday after 5:30pm. No summer school or park district activities are being held on Fridays.

- d. Currently interviewing for a replacement for Mary Pat Witmer, who is retiring at the end of the school year.
- e. Please complete the online annual update as soon as possible.

- f. Please encourage friends with incoming kindergarteners to register with the district office. Of the 78 confirmed incoming kindergarten students, only 50 have registered with the district. This prevents administration from being able to hire a fourth section teacher. We expect to have four sections of kindergarten, however the position is not approved until enough students register with the district.
