- a. Thank you for a smooth start to the school year and for your attendance at Meet the Teacher as well as Curriculum Night. Students and staff are transitioning back into the routines of school and we are excited about the year ahead.
- b. Safety Reminders

 - ii. Supervision Before and After School
 - 1. Students should not be unsupervised in the morning before we open the doors at 8 am.
 - 2. Students playing on the playground or in the fields after school must have adult supervision.
- c. 5th Grade Specials Pilot Schedule
 - i. We are excited to share an exciting opportunity that Prairie will be piloting for the 2024-2025 school year. In an effort to look at the music experience for our students in an innovative way, we are excited to explore this new specials schedule that will be beneficial to all of our students in 5th grade.
 - ii. To accommodate full rehearsals for our band and orchestra students, we will be piloting an adjusted specials schedule. Students in 5th grade who participate in band and orchestra will attend full rehearsals weekly during one of their two weekly general music rotations. This means they will not miss any of their core academic classes to attend full band or orchestra rehearsals. Rehearsals will be integrated into their existing schedule and they will still participate in general music with Mrs. Boesso one day a week. The standards and quality of music instruction will remain consistent.
 - iii. The remainder of the students, who are not in band or orchestra, will be mixed with students from other classes. This new arrangement is similar to the junior high model of "exploratories," where students have the opportunity to interact with students in other classrooms. Students will still participate in PE and music two times a week and art and LC one time a week.

Teachers at Prairie use multiple measures to monitor and plan for each student's success, including classroom assessments, observations, daily work, and other formative tools. This comprehensive approach ensures a well-rounded understanding of each student's needs and strengths.
