

DAILY BELL SCHEDULES



Monday & Friday: Regular school day schedule 7:45 a.m. - 3:10 p.m. Classes are 50 minutes each.

Weekly Wednesday Late Arrival: First period begins at 9:00 a.m. All class periods are shortened. Dismissal is at 3:10 p.m.

Tuesday & Thursday: The school day still runs from 7:45 – 3:10, with a 45 minute homeroom period inserted between periods 2 & 3. All class periods are shortened.

Half-Days: First period begins at 7:45 a.m. All class periods are shortened. Dismissal is at noon.

TRANSPORTATION

Bus Information: Busses drop students off on the east side of the building at entrance E4. On Late Arrival days, busses arrive at their stops 1 hour and 40 minutes later than their usual pick-up time. Students must have their student I.D. with them while riding the bus.

Parent Drop off/Pick up: Parents may drop off/pick up students at the main entrance (E1) or the auditorium entrance (E8). In addition, students may be dropped off in the bus lot after 7:15 am on regular school days and after 8:45 am on late arrival days.
