

# Free and Reduced Lunch Program Application Information and Instructions

District 203 offers free and reduced-price school meals and milk to students from households that meet the federal income guidelines to qualify under the National School Lunch Programs. All meals provided meet the U.S.D.A. requirements. Detailed information regarding which items are included in a Free or Reduced lunch will be included with acceptance letters.

Students currently receiving food stamps (SNAP) or “Temporary Assistance for Needy Families” (TANF) or are pre-certified by the state certified based on the income reported on the Illinois All-Kids or Medicaid application do not need to fill out an application if the family receives a pre-certification letter from District 203. Pre-certification letters will be mailed before the start of the school year.
