# A Student's Guide to NNHS Free/Reduced Lunch and Waiver Information



### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**LUNCH:** Students that are eligible for free or reduced lunch are required to choose a combo lunch. Students are required to take the vegetable, fruit and milk or juice as part of their combo meal in order to comply with USDA regulations. Students who are on reduced lunch pay 40¢.

**SCHOOL FEES:** Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch are entitled to a waiver of school fees. School fees include all class fees, concert attire and drivers education. Please note that school fees *do not include*: school supplies, library fines, replacement costs for textbooks or library books, class rings, yearbooks, pictures, admission charges for dances, athletic events or other social events.

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION:** One PE t-shirt and one PE lock will be provided free of charge. Additional items may be purchased in the School Store at regular cost.

**FIELD TRIPS:** All curricular field trips are covered; a voucher needs to be obtained from **Nandini Asar**, Financial Secretary in the Main Office. All BSLA and LASA field trips that occur during the school day are covered.

### **SENIOR EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES**

Senior year is a time for special events and activities. Families, who qualify for federal assistance through the national school lunch program (free/reduced lunch), are able to receive some additional benefits for senior students through the generosity of some of our vendors and school-based assistance plans. Because some events have a cost associated with them and some items are purchased from outside vendors, price reductions are not possible for everything. To assist families in planning, the following has been put into place:

**FREE SENIOR PHOTO YEARBOOK SITTING FOR STANDARD YEARBOOK – ROOT STUDIOS/HR IMAGING:** This is available to ALL students. In order to make it into the yearbook, this must be taken by the annual deadline at Root Studios, 1701 Quincy Avenue, Unit 13, Naperville. An appointment card is mailed home in the spring. This is usually taken during the summer months. Root Studios can be reached at 630-416-0552. Tell them you want to schedule a yearbook photo for Naperville North High School.

**COLLEGE APPLICATION FEES:** Students who qualify for Free/Reduced lunch are also eligible for fee waivers for their college applications. Please see your school counselor in Student Services for more information.

FREE CAP/GOWN/STOLE and TASSEL: The student/parent is responsible for filling out the order form. Jostens will be at school during lunches in the cafeteria on select days in August and September. If you do not order at this time, it is your responsibility to call Jostens at 630-963-3500. Please see Elizabeth Baron, Assistant to the Dean of Student Activities, if you qualify for a waiver. You must go to the Student Activities Office for your cap and gown to be waived.

# **FREE TO ALL SENIORS**

**Senior Assembly & Lunch**: This is on Cap & Gown Distribution Day in April.

**Exit with Pride:** This is held at Centennial Beach in May.

**Participation in Graduation Ceremony:** There is a mandatory rehearsal the morning of graduation.



#### **OPTIONAL ITEMS**

The following items are optional and *are not* covered by the free/reduced lunch waivers.

**Senior Brunch:** This is held the day of graduation and the ticket price is \$35.

**Senior Celebration:** This is held in April and is a celebration for seniors only! The price is \$50 if paid first semester and \$60 after January 1<sup>st</sup>. See Student Activities if you need assistance.

**Senior Ad in the Yearbook:** Cost is \$60 and ordered online from the Yearbook Company, it includes a note from parents and a personal photo. Price goes up monthly.
