School Improvement Plan

Looking at global data, the district identified four schools with achievement gaps. Mill Street was identified as one of those schools and will be given added support for the next three years to close this achievement gap. Literacy, math and social/emotional learning support will be given to ensure that all students are achieving. We have created a PLC room for teachers to meet two times per week to evaluate data and plan for how to help students move from one level to the next using Standards Based Reporting. My personal goals are to first bring SIP resources to teachers and ensure high impact instruction is given to meet student needs. In addition, build a culture of trust with staff and partnership with the community.
