Welcome back to the 2017-2018 school year. As the new principal at Mill Street, I couldn't be more excited to begin this year and share with you how we will make this school year the best yet for our students and community! There are many exciting changes that have occurred over the summer at Mill Street, the most exciting of which is that we welcome many new teachers and support staff to our building.

Through a District 203 Board of Education initiative to support identified schools in closing achievement gaps through additional resources, we welcome 22 certified and several support staff this year. The addition of new staff enables us to not only provide additional classrooms and thus smaller class sizes, but expanded expertise and support in providing differentiated and high impact instruction to ensure all students are achieving to their fullest potential.

The building itself has undergone upgrades to the Learning Commons space to support instruction and a greater capability to support a Maker's Space area in which students explore and create using a variety of STEM and technology based resources. The building hallways have been painted with an updated color pallet and our structured learning staff and students will enjoy a new state of the art classroom to support their learning. We also have new spaces for our English Language Learners, Honors and PI students, band students, our students with academic learning needs and for teachers to plan, learn and collaborate with one another.
