- Hybrid going well since kids have been back in the buildings.
- Summer School is rolling out. Plan on doing some extended offerings based on what they are seeing in the testing.
- BOE had a surplus this year of \$10million. Tax reimbursement to Naperville property
 owners are currently in place. Also the district is refunding general school fees this year
 to student families. Also due to the surplus the district will offer more summer school
 programs.
- Joe really enjoyed coffee with the principal. A great way to engage with the principal.
- Currently looking for a replacement for Janet Rohr's seat on BOE.

Administration Reports:

Principal Report: Jay Wachtel

- Currently, the mitigations NNHS is following are working and working well! As parents, please stay vigilant on social distancing and safe practices at home.
 The Covid communications will start to include a number count on positive cases.
- Lockdown Friday morning was due to construction in school. The ALICE training
 worked within the school. Some students evacuated the building while others locked
 down in the classroom. This was a pure accident, the policy is to always give ample
 warning if there is an ALICE drill.
- Week 3 of hybrid model teachers and students are overcoming the challenges that
 come along with change. Vibe and energy in school is positive. Approx. 30% of school
 is online only. The check-in process is going smoothly. Surveillance testing is going
 well. Would love more of a participation in testing. If a student forgets a sample, you
 can bring it another day. Again, students who are not currently participating can opt in
 at any time.

Jen Baumgartner - Student Activities

- Still planning all the senior activities for year end! Currently waiting to hear about locations, numbers and times. Sending surveys to Seniors to get a feel on what kids will attend and are interested in doing so we plan accordingly!
- Virtual Childrens Play is next weekend.
- Students will have a spring play and a spring musical.
- Booster Club Fashion Show will not be happening this year.
- Will start talking to juniors in the upcoming weeks to start continuing the traditions school has had in the past. Goal is to get younger classmen involved again in leadership programs.
- DVC Dance Competition is next friday teams will dance on video. The judges will watch the videos to give out awards in another room.

Guest speaker - Rakeda Leaks - her 3rd year in District 203. Her role is to develop a comprehensive equity plan being implemented over 3 years. Have had a lot of focus groups with teachers and parents and students to review the plan as well and give their feedback.

BOE approval went public in late October 2020. The plan consists of 5 pillars of success working in tandem with current initiatives in the district. Identified goals hope to be accomplished by 2023 (3 yr plan) with an optimal learning environment for all kids. Can find information on the district website. Big part of the plan is to look into the curriculum. Make sure that curriculum is connecting to all kids. "When kids feel a connection they learn more and build confidence." Want to give kids the opportunity to see all students represented and feel connected to learn more about their backgrounds as well as others in a positive manner. This month is Black History month, a compiled list of local virtual events for the community to be part of is on the website as well as other events, such as the Chinese New Year coming up. Equity Institute day is coming up for staff which provides education and training for our staff on equity. The plan is comprehensive and includes students and staff in the 3 year roll out.

- 1. Has Late arrival been discussed for High School? Other than their asynchronous Mondays?
 - We will continue to have one late start at the HS level which is the current model.
- 2. Since some teachers will be teaching at home using Zoom, will there be a teacher in the classroom with the students? Is this occurring a lot across the district (teachers remaining at home)?
 - When a teacher is teaching from home on zoom, there will be another adult in the room to supervise students.
- 3. Will there be an in-person learning pause (like Thanksgiving/Holiday break) after Spring Break?
 - At this time, we have not determined if we will move the District to all remote following spring break. It will be determined closer to that date based on current health metrics and cases in our community.
