


### Important Factors to Consider

- > Average 5-8 applications (app fee + test scores)
- > Far Reach & Dream Schools?
  - O Have back-up Plans B, C, and D

- > Explore Colleges & Develop Your List
  - · Use SchooLinks
  - Keep Lines of Communication Open
- > Know How You Compare
  - O Use Scattergrams in Schoolinks
  - Be realistic (Reach / Target / Safety)
  - Affordability/cost

# Apprenticeships/Trades


- > On the job training, lasts from 1-6 years depending on the trade

# Military


- > Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (A.S.V.A.B.)
  - Career Exploration Program includes multiple aptitude tests and interest inventories
  - O Tests administered in October/November
- > AirForce
