



Kingsley Home & School Committee Volunteer Opportunities

Kingsley Home & School is a parent-driven, volunteer-based organization – and as the parents/guardians of Kingsley students, you are automatically members! The volunteer opportunities below are representative of the different kinds of help we need during the school year. There are volunteer opportunities for every schedule and amount of availability; some can be done at home in the evenings, or with young kids at home! Options are available to chair a committee, serve on a committee, or volunteer when events come up!

5th Grade Representative: Help with the 5th grade t-shirts, yard signs, and end of the year party for the 5th graders.

Bake Sale: Set up the Sign Up Genius for donations of baked goods and other treats; sell treats during Open House bake sale. Count money.

Book Fair: Set up and/or tear down the book fair; set up the Sign Up Genius for parent volunteers, assist younger students with making wish lists, ring up purchases, count money.

Cards for Knights: Assist with sorting and labeling gift card orders for staff.

Classroom Parties: *Head Room Parent:* coordinate the party volunteers for all three parties in their child's classroom. *Party volunteer:* coordinate a game or craft for one of their child's class parties.

Dining out Days: Contact local restaurants and set up fundraiser events for the Kingsley community.

Family Fun Events: Help create community at Kingsley outside of the school day by organizing events for families. These may include: Movie nights, Trunk or Treat, Multicultural Night, etc.

Field Day: Help with a station or class during Field Day.

Ice Cream Social: Help with ice cream ordering, sales; assist with event activities.

Kingsley Spring Event: Organize the event or serve on a committee to coordinate a springtime event; coordinate with vendors/entertainment, make purchases, set up and clean up, solicit donations for the silent auction, among other things. (Running of the Knights or a Knights' Night Out)

Social Media: Communicate with parents using the Home & School Facebook account, design event flyers for backpack mail

Spirit Wear: Coordinate with vendors to design and choose spirit wear options available for purchase by Kingsley families, design and order Kindergarten t-shirts, distribute orders, sales at events.

Staff Appreciation: Help celebrate staff during various weeks, teacher meals during conferences and teacher appreciation week.

Supply packets: Coordinate with staff to create supply packets for each grade, set up ordering and payments, distribute supply packets to classrooms ahead of the first day of school.

Teacher raffle: Coordinate with staff rep to set up teacher raffle options and ticket sales.

Thanks and Giving Store: Organize the store, set up and clean up of the store, assist students in choosing gifts and managing their money; ring up students' purchases; wrap and label students' purchases.

Yearbook: Take and submit pictures at events throughout the year, help with design and production of the yearbook, distribute yearbooks.
